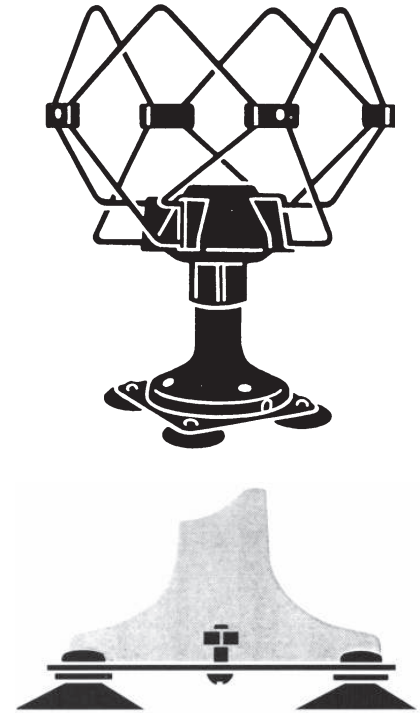
How to fit your Maxview Suction Pad Base

1. Detach the Omnimax Antenna from its base. Remove the inverted 'U' section in the base to allow the cable to exit from the antenna.
2. Fix the antenna base to the Suction Pad Base by using the three nuts and bolts provided. Don't forget to fit the gasket supplied between antenna base and Suction Pad Base (refer to Omnimax instructions).

This accessory is suitable for stationary vehicles i.e. static caravans or slow moving craft, such as cabin cruisers.

To ensure maximum adhesion, smear a little washing up liquid on each pad before bringing into contact, and make sure the fixing surface is clean and smooth.

**Caution:** If the aerial and/or base is left attached to your vehicle while on the move, it could become dislodged by low overhanging branches or protruding objects.

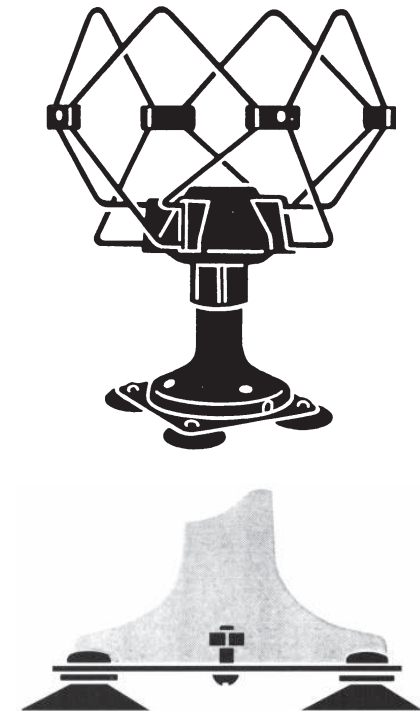
