Maxview Launch 12 & 230 Volt Freesat+ Digital Video Recorder

Satellite and Terrestrial reception manufacturer Maxview, have this month launched a recording version of their highly successful Freesat satellite TV receiver called Freesat+. Following on from the launch of the Freesat satellite service, a not for profit, joint venture between the BBC and ITV in May 2008, Maxview have been developing a wide range of solutions for television reception on the move and this product now gives every motor homer and caravanner the ability to record when away from home.

The Freesat service is a no contract, no subscription platform that provides over 140 channels, free high definition programs from the BBC and ITV as well as digital radio, subtitles and the interactive Red Button service allowing viewers to access additional channels and content.

The Freesat+ DVR receivers branded under the Goodmans and Grundig brands have a second tuner inside that allows you not only to record one channel but also to watch another whilst recording. The GFSDTR320HB receiver allows up to 80 hours HD and 200 hours SD recording time from the 320GB hard drive and requires a twin LNB which is optional on all of Maxview's new satellite dish systems

In addition the receiver allows you to Pause live TV, the receiver is continuously recording the channel you are watching so that you can press the Pause button should you get interrupted and go back to the program when you want. With the twin tuner you can even record two channels at the same time, there is also smart technology inside that looks throughout the 7 day electronic program guide (EPG) to check if the same program is being recorded at a different time to allow you to record it whenever it is on allowing you to watch any other channel. For those motor homers and caravanners who have SKY+ at home this system provides them with the same type of technology but without contract or subscription but most importantly you can take it away with you.

The receiver box also comes complete with an HDMI cable allowing the system to be connected to a HD Ready Flat screen TV and give you full High Definition TV reception when away from the home on the move. The power supply to the box enables you to connect to both 12 volts or to connect it to a 230 volt mains supply if you on a hook up. Its small size of just 30cm wide and 26cm deep with a height of 5cm means that it can be place in a cupboard or under you HD TV.

Finally Maxview have tried to provide the very best level of customer service with this and all of their Freesat receivers by offering a home installation for the products when you are not using them in your vehicles. Inside each box is an installation leaflet that gives you a telephone number to call to have an installer come to your house and fit a satellite dish and connect it to your main TV and get you up and running with Freesat at home for just £80. This gives you all of the same 140 channels, High Definition content and means that you don't have to have two boxes.
