## Maxview Makes Finding the Digital Signals Simple

UK aerial manufacturer Maxview are making life easier for everyone arriving on site looking for the new digital TV signal by combining their new Digital Tick Touring TV aerial with the new digital signal finder.

Now that the digital switchover is now completed in many parts of the South West, campers and caravanners alike will be able to benefit from the higher quality digital TV and radio signal, all they have to do is find it! The digital signal finder has a series of 5 LED's that illuminate when you locate the digital TV signal and help you to accurately align the aerial to get the full signal.

Maxview makes this easy with the inclusion of their digital signal finder and a new longer length cable, now 10 meters enabling you to place the aerial in the best place for TV reception on your pitch.

Steven May of Maxview explained "With almost all televisions having an auto tune facility will only receive the digital TV signal if the aerial is aligned with a relatively small acceptance angle. As a directional TV aerial only has an acceptance angle of around 20 degrees you must be accurately aligned. If your aerial is at 21 degrees you will receive nothing of the digital TV signal. With the old analogue signal you have a chance of getting a signal whereas digital provides no such opportunity. We decided to add the digital signal finder to the Digital Tick Touring aerial, as we appreciate our customer is going around to different locations and want a quick and simple set up."

Having been out on sites during the first part of the year Maxview had seen many caravanners with their aerials set up and the cable stretched tight between the aerial and the van. Steven May added "We decided to extend the cable from a 5m length to a 10m length having seen the challenge of locating the digital signal on site. Doubling the length now means that you can route the cable safely from the aerial to your digital TV".
